## MODERN SAMPLE TIMELINE

1pm - 2:30pm

Getting Ready

*Based off 1 photographer  
covering bride & groom at same location  
(example: 1 hotel in 2 different hotel rooms)*

30 Min: Groom getting ready photos

1 Hour: Bride getting ready photos

Capturing the groom's side first, I ask that groom and groomsmen be dressed in pants and undershirt upon arrival. I focus on details like shoes, boutonnieres, rings, etc. Then capture candids of the grooms crew helping him get ready.

I arrive for the bride's photos just in time for hair and makeup to be finishing up, capturing all her favourite little details...earrings, shoes, rings, dress. I then move to candids of the bride and her crew getting ready. Then its the big moment, putting on the DRESS!

3pm - 4:30pm

First Look

First look photos are one of my favourite parts of a wedding day! I will find the perfect, most private location as possible for these photos. After you have had your time for first look and some romantic portraits, its time to invite the wedding party to share in the excitement.

5pm - 5:30pm

Ceremony

It's time to get married!

5:30pm - 6pm

Family Portraits

Family photos take place immediately after the ceremony on location. It's best to save all the family formals until after the ceremony because all family members will be present at this time. I will get a list of family arrangements you want ahead of time to make sure we don't miss any family members.

6pm - 9pm

Reception

Portrait time is now over and I focus on the main events of your evening starting with the bridal party entrance. I stay until the scheduled events of the evening are complete (around 9pm)

7pm - 7:15pm

Sunset Photos

I like to sneak out with the bride and groom for 15 minutes to capture a few portraits at the BEST time of day ...golden hour. These generally turn out to be the couples favourite shots, mine too!

**4pm - 5:30pm**

Bridal Portraits

I allot a minimum of 1.5 hrs to capture intimate photos of the bride and groom and bridal party portraits. If these photos are at a second location off the ceremony site, you may need more time added to accommodate driving time.

**6pm - 9pm**

Reception

Portrait time is now over and I focus on the main events of your evening starting with the bridal party entrance. I stay until the scheduled events of the evening are complete (around 9pm)

**7pm - 7:15pm**

Sunset Photos

I like to sneak out with the bride and groom for 15 minutes to capture a few portraits at the BEST time of day ...golden hour. These generally turn out to be the couples favourite shots, mine too!
